If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Your program must be Quality Rated by December 31, 2020 in order to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Sign up for Quality Rated by June 30, 2018 in order to be eligible to receive a bonus package.

591-1-1-.25(13) requires that potentially hazardous equipment, materials and supplies be stored in a locked area inaccessible to children. It was determined by consultant observation that inside of the first left Pre-K classroom a bottle of hand sanitizer was inside of a child's book bag also in the first left Early Head Start classroom a jar of petroleum jelly and a jar of Johnson's Baby Colonge.was observed inside of a child's book bag. Also, inside of a child's book bag in classroom D a small tube of hand sanitizer was attached to the side of a child's bag.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will identify all hazardous items and keep them in a locked area inaccessible to children. The Center will inform all Staff about hazardous items and the safe storage of those items.

Finding

591-1-1-.25(17) requires that the Center premises be free of plants and shrubs which are poisonous or hazardous. It was determined by consultant observation that on the far back area of the playground along the wooden fence ivy or sumac was present growing along the fencing.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on consultant's that tree root were exposed and posing a tripping hazard on the far left back play area, the wooden landscaping was observed to be rotten and exposed protruding nails in the same area, as well as the far back 6 ft fence bottom wooden base board was detached with exposed protruding nails. In addition there was trash particles emanating throughout the playground posing a hazard to children while playing.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.
