### **Comments**

An Administrative Review was conducted on September 17, 2020. Staff files, children's files, training and background checks were all reviewed. A virtual inspection was conducted on September 21, 2020 with the Director. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Compliance with the Executive Order issued August 15, 2020 was discussed during the virtual inspection.

New rules starting October 1, 2020 were discussed with the provider during the virtual inspection. A copy of the new infant feeding plan was emailed to the provider on September 21, 2020.

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)
