Previously Cited: 591-1-1-.26(8) requires the playground to be kept clean, free of litter and hazards. It was determined based on consultants observations that several broken buckets, Frisbee and other plastic toys were observed in the water table on the lower portion of the playground on this date.

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation the following hazards were observed:

- *Cracked buckets with rust were observed in the water table on the lower portion of the playground.
- *Sharp concrete blocks are exposed around the anchoring of the Seesaw.
- *Plastic wrappers were thrown away on the ground by the brown bench
- *Erosion has occurred by the sidewalk causing a tripping hazard
- *Three exposed white water pipes are posing a potential tripping hazard

POI (Plan of Improvement)

Previously Cited: To ensure the cleanliness, sanitation and safety of the playground, the center will remove broken toys for the playground.

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.

Provider will add more dirt/mulch to ensure exposed cement rocks and tripping hazards are covered.
