## Finding

591-1-1-.33(3) requires each staff member with direct care responsibilities to complete health and safety training at the time of employment that will count toward required annual training: Staff employed prior to September 30, 2016 will complete the training by December 29, 2016 and Staff employed after September 30, 2016 will complete the health and safety training within the first 90 days of employment. It was determined based on review of staff files that three staff members that have been employed for over 90 days had not completed the health and safety training as required. Director stated the staff are scheduled to take the class March 10, 2018.
