#### Comments

This Monitoring Visit is the first regulatory visit for Treutlen Head Start this 2019 - 2020 fiscal year. The center director stated one new staff member has been hired since the consultant's last visit. The consultant observed all staff to have a satisfactory comprehensive fingerprint criminal records clearance determination letter on file. The center director stated no routine transportation is provided and no off site field trips are provided. The consultant observed the center to be having an on site field trip with the Soperton County Fire Department.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. Please see GBI's website located at http://gbi.georgia.gov to access the Georgia Sex Offender Registry.

(O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)
