- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

It was determined based on investigative findings that on June 18, 2021, at approximately 4:20 p.m., a two-year-old child sustained an injury to the leg as a result of staff members not redirecting a child from climbing on the wooden cubbies that fell on top of the child in the classroom.
