#### Comments

The consultant completed an on site visit on 01-31-2022. The center director stated there is a total of 4 staff members with 1 of the 4 staff being a new hire since the consultant's last visit. The center director stated medication is administered, no field trips or routine transportation is provided. The consultant request documents to be uploaded into Koala by close of business on February 7, 2022 for review of the administrative review. The administrative review was completed on 02-03-2022. The consultant discussed the findings with the center director. The consultant emailed a copy of the report to the director and request a date and signature to be emailed to the consultant by 02-04-2022.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or quardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)
