This Monitoring Visit is the first regulatory visit for Wayne Head Start this 2018 - 2019 fiscal year.

The consultant reviewed all staff files and finds that each staff member has a satisfactory fingerprint criminal records clearance determination letter on file. The consultant discussed with the center director that as of October 1, 2018 all staff members are required to have a comprehensive CBC on file.

The center director stated no medication has been administered since the beginning of this school term. No field trips have been taken since the beginning of this school term and routine transportation is provided. No transportation was observed during this visit.

The center currently has a two star Quality Rating.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on the consultant's observation and measurement that the double chain link gates located on the back right corner of the child playground area has a five inch gap at the bottom of the gates and a eight inch gap at the top of the gates causing a potential entrapment hazard.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will routinely check the fence to determine if it is in good repair and remains at least 4 feet high, and will repair any hazards. The Center will train Staff to identify and report any fence hazards and to keep the fence gates closed when not in use.
