

591-1-1-.32(7) requires that children be supervised at all times and that the persons supervising in the child care area be alert, able to respond promptly to the needs and actions of the children being supervised, as well as the actions of the chaperones and Students-in-Training, and provide timely attention to the children's actions and needs. It was determined, based on observation, that three children were observed in the cafeteria without a staff member providing supervision for approximately two minutes, as all staff were in the gym or in the computer lab at this time. It was further determined that seven children were observed to run into the cafeteria from the gym without staff supervision for approximately thirty seconds before a staff member entered the cafeteria from the gym.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff and monitor to ensure they are providing supervision and watchful oversight to the children at all times.
