If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that exposed concrete was accessible to the children on the ground near the picnic table on the left side of the outdoor play area. The concrete appeared to be left over from old equipment that had been removed. Additionally, the plastic liner used underneath mulch and wood chips was observed to be accessible on the right side of the first picnic table near the fence, posing a possible tripping hazard. Inactive ant beds were observed near the fence located between the preschool play area at the rear of the building and the toddler play area. A large inactive ant bed was observed near the fence inside the toddler play area and another inactive ant bed was observed near the far right side of the swing set located in the toddler play area located on the side of the building.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards. The center will cover or remove any exposed concrete and plastic liner. Inactive ant beds were also observed. The center will ensure the ant beds are removed and continue to treat any new ant beds that may occur, while ensuring they are inaccessible to the children.
