- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.03(9) requires center staff to refrain from engaging in, or allowing children or other adults to engage in, activities that could be detrimental to a child's health or well-being, such as but not limited to, horse play, rough play, wrestling, and picking up a child in a manner that could cause injury. It was determined based on an investigation that on August 13, 2020 an infant was inappropriately picked up by one arm from the floor by a staff member. Video footage shows that on August 13, 2020 at 8:31 a.m. a staff member was observed standing by a counter when an infant rolled over behind them. The staff member turns to see the infant on the floor and pulls the infant up by one arm to lift the infant up to hold. The infant did not appear to be in distress, however the manner in which the infant was handled was inappropriate and could have caused injury.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will review requirements with Staff to ensure that infants are picked up appropriately.
