- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

591-1-1-.12(2) requires that all equipment and furniture be free from hazardous conditions such as, but not limited to, sharp rough edges or toxic paint; and be kept clean. It was determined, based on observation, that the blue vinyl couch in the Middle Classroom in Building One and the red vinyl couch and chair cushions in Building Two were observed to have tears with foam exposed, which prevented the furniture from being able to be kept clean on this date.

The Center will ensure that equipment and furniture are used by the age-appropriate group of children.

It was determined, based on review of records, that the director and three staff participating in routine transportation were lacking current evidence of completing the required two hours of state-approved transportation training on this date, as required biannually.

The Center will ensure that the Director, Center Staff, and any person responsible for the transportation of children has completed the required transportation training.

It was determined, based on observation, that mats in the Back Classroom were observed to have tears with foam exposed on this date, which prevented the mats from being washable and able to be sanitized as required.

The Center will ensure that cots and mats are of sound construction and of sufficient size to accommodate the size and weight of the child and mats are in good repair, washable, covered with a waterproof material and is at least two inches thick.
