Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Your program must be Quality Rated by December 31, 2020 in order to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Sign up for Quality Rated by June 30, 2018 in order to be eligible to receive a bonus package.

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Finding

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that the fencing on the left middle section across from the bike trail is measuring three feet, five inches due to the pile up of resilient materials.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will routinely check the fence to determine if it is in good repair and remains at least 4 feet high, and will repair any hazards. The Center will train Staff to identify and report any fence hazards and to keep the fence gates closed when not in use.

Technical Assistance

591-1-1-.26(6) - The consultant provided technical assistance on a Little Tikes multi color gym set. The gym set has a large crack on the slide and a large crack on the crawl through tunnel. The gym set was taped off when the consultant arrived, the center director stated the gym set had been taped off and the children aren't allowed to play on it. The director stated that severe winds had blown the tape off of the gym set. The director has spoke with the Board of Ed. for assistance in having this piece of equipment removed from the playground. The consultant did not observe any children playing on the gym set during this visit. The center director stated the removal of this piece of equipment will become a priority.
