(O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Finding

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that the fencing on the left middle section across from the bike trial is measuring three feet, five inches due to the pile up of resilient materials.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will routinely check the fence to determine if it is in good repair and remains at least 4 feet high, and will repair any hazards. The Center will train Staff to identify and report any fence hazards and to keep the fence gates closed when not in use.

The gym set was taped off when the consultant arrived , the center director stated the gym set had been taped off and the children aren't allowed to play on it. The director stated that severe winds had blown the tape off of the gym set. The director has spoke with the Board of Ed. for assistance in having this piece of equipment removed from the playground. The consultant did not observe any children playing on the gym set during this visit. The center director stated the removal of this piece of equipment will become a priority.
