Consultant discussed with the Director that all exposed tree routes in the outdoor play area should be marked with a high visibility spray paint to eliminate them as a tripping hazard.

#### **Finding**

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined, based on observations, that the bottom of the chain link fencing was not properly anchored and stabilized and was presenting an entrapment if pushed at the bottom.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will routinely check the fence to determine if it is in good repair and remains at least 4 feet high, and will repair any hazards. The Center will train Staff to identify and report any fence hazards and to keep the fence gates closed when not in use.

The Consultant discussed ways to anchor the fencing with the Director on this date.
