If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

It was determined based on observation that live ants were located on the preschool playground. It was further observed that vines were on various areas of the fence on the back right and far back preschool playground. In addition, it was determined that the blue play structure on the preschool playground was missing a seat.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove any litter, ants, and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.

It was determined based on observation that the children did not wash their hands while re-entering the classroom after outside play.

The Center will train Staff on required handwashing for children and Staff will ensure children's hands are washed when required. The Director will monitor for compliance.
