

Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. It was determined based on observation that one of four child size chairs on the left side classroom had part of the molding broken with sharp edges.

The Center will ensure that equipment and furniture are used by the age-appropriate group of children. The center will remove or repair chair.

Finding

591-1-1-.25(8) requires protective caps on all unused electrical outlets within children's reach and requires that electrical outlets in use be made inaccessible to children. It was determined based on observation that the following was present:

Front classroom- the television cords were not secured to the wall.

Left side- the television cords were not secured to the wall.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff to check outlets and replace protective caps when needed and identify and monitor how outlets in use are inaccessible to children. The center will secure all cords.

Discussed maintenance of resilient surface. Please fluff and redistribute.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(6) requires that playground equipment provide an opportunity for the children to engage in a variety of experiences and shall be age-appropriate. For example, toddlers shall not be permitted to swing in swings designed for School-age Children. The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined that the following hazards were present:

Upper play area:

Two white landscaping pipes were not attached having a 4"x4" opening on four ends posing an entrapment hazard. One opening also was broken with sharp edges.

Lower play area:

Three white landscaping pipes were not attached having a 4"x4" opening on three ends posing an entrapment hazard. One opening was also broken with sharp edges.

One basketball goal was rusted.

One of four swings seats were cracked.

Four of four S hooks were rusted.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will provide a variety of age-appropriate equipment that is arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. Staff will check the equipment daily to ensure that the equipment is free of hazards, rust and splinters. The center will replace S hooks, remove the basketball goal and repair the white pipes while securing them.
