If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. It was determined based on observation that in classroom A, there was a kitchen knife stored in an unlocked drawer beside the sink and within reach of children in care as well as a stapler and three tape dispensers stored on teacher's desks.

The knife was moved to a cabinet out of reach of children in care during the visit. The center will ensure that all potentially hazardous items are stored out of reach of children in care.
