- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- · New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

It was determined based on observation the after school back middle classroom was over capacity in that there were 23 children in a classroom with a licensed capacity for 20 children.

The Center will limit the number of children in this space to the licensed capacity.

Finding

591-1-1-.25(3) requires the Center and surrounding premises to be kept clean, free of debris and in good repair. Hygienic measures such as, but not limited to, screened windows and proper waste disposal procedures shall be utilized to minimize the presence of rodents, flies, roaches and other vermin at the Center. It was determined based on observation the following classrooms were observed to have the following hazards present:

- * Chipped paint was observed on walls and baseboards throughout in the third left, third right, fourth right, fifth right, Pre-K four B and C, and the after school back middle classrooms.
- * Chipped paint was observed on the hand rails of the infant changing table in the first right classroom.
- * Cabinets surrounding the diaper changing tables in the second left and third left classrooms were observed to be warped and not in good repair.
- * Carpet in the after school back middle classroom was observed to not be in good repair as the carpet was observed to be frayed and separated from the floor throughout the middle of the classroom area.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will have the Center and surrounding areas cleaned, make repairs where needed, and remove all debris is removed. The Center will implement a plan to keep areas clean and in good repair that includes regular monitoring. The center will paint and repair all walls and baseboards in each classroom.

It was determined based on observation children were observed to transition from outside into the first left classroom and did not wash their hands immediately upon entering the classroom as required. Additionally, no hand soap was available for children to wash their hands in the fifth right classroom.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff on required handwashing for children and Staff will ensure children's hands are washed when required. The Director will monitor for compliance.

When storage is available and used for the storage of cots and mats that allows the cots, mats and any bedding to be stored without touching any other cots, mats or bedding, the bedding may be left on the cot or mat. When such storage is not available for the cots and mats, each child's bedding shall be kept separate from other children's bedding and stored in containers marked for individual use, such as, but not limited to, bins, cubbies, or bags. It was determined based on observation blankets in the second left and fifth right classrooms were observed to be touching and not stored properly as required.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will store cots and mats so children do not have access to them and they don't take up play space and will store them so each child's bedding is separate from the others.
