The investigation remains open on this date, pending additional information. Upon completion the finding will be reviewed with the provider and a final copy of the report will be sent.

The purpose of today's visit was to conduct a follow up to a visit conducted on September 2, 2020 and to conduct a complaint investigation. Investigative findings were not concluded on this date. Once investigative findings have been concluded by the assigned Child Care Consultant, the provider will be notified of any findings. The complaint investigation remains open at this time. The Child Care Consultant completing today's visit has provided their business card with complete contact information. Please contact the visiting consultant if there are any individuals affiliated the CCLC diagnosed with COVID-19 in the next 14 days, after the visit has taken place. Affiliated individuals may include, but are not limited to the provider, household members, children in care, and family members of children in care. The current Executive Order was utilized during today's visit and the provider demonstrated compliance with the current order.

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

591-1-1-.12(1) - requires each Employee and child in attendance to use all indoor and outdoor furniture, activity materials, and equipment in a safe and appropriate manner and in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions, recommendations, and intended use. All equipment and furniture shall be used only by the age-appropriate group of children. The Consultant observed small round tables in multiple areas of the center and the bases of the tables were constructed out of PVC piping. The tables may pose a potential tipping hazard.
