

#### 591-1-1-.08 Children's Records

#### Finding

591-1-1.08(6) requires the Center to maintain records of a child's daily arrival and departure for the twelve (12) preceding months that the Parent or person(s) authorized by the Parent documents, in written or electronic format, each time the Parent or authorized person drops off and picks up the child. The documentation shall include at least the date, the child's name, the arrival and departure times, and the signature or initials of the Parent or authorized person at the time of arrival and departure. These records shall be made available to the Department in printed or written form upon request. It was determined based on the consultant's review of sign in and sign out sheets and child head count that 8 infants are present and five are signed in. Additionally, 9 one and two-year old children are present and six are signed in. Additionally, 16 three to five year old children are present and 18 are signed in.

The Center will maintain arrival and departure records as required, will ensure the documentation includes all of the required information, and will provide the records to the Department when requested.
