If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

It was determined based on consultant's review of records, 3 of 8 staff did not have verification of completion of 10 clock hours of state approved training for 2017.

The Center will plan and schedule the required 10 hours of annual training each year and follow up to ensure the training is completed.
