

The center currently has a two star Quality Rating.

The consultant reviewed all staff files and finds that each staff member has a satisfactory fingerprint criminal records clearance determination letter on file. The consultant discussed with the center director that effective October 1, 2018 all staff members will be required to have a comprehensive fingerprint criminal records clearance determination letter on file prior to their first day of employment.

The center director stated no medication is administered, no field trips or routine transportation is provided.

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance.
