If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

It was determined based on consultant's observation that the center mixed age groups as classroom B was observed to have 4; 2 year olds, 6; 3 year olds, 1; 4 year old, 1; 5 year old, 1; 9 year old and a 13 year old in a classroom with one staff member.

The Center will provide adequate staff when there is a mixed-age group.
