- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. Please see GBI's website located at http://gbi.georgia.gov to access the Georgia Sex Offender Registry.

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Please fluff and redistribute Please ensure six inches of resilient surface material is maintained underneath all swinging and climbing equipment with the exception of the toddler sliding board, it was discussed that a minimum of three inches should be maintained around that piece of equipment. Discussed removing tree limbs any any accumulation of sweet gum balls from the play area. Discussed moving the wood borders surrounding the equipment back at least five feet on each side. Discussed covering the rocks surrounding the tree near the toddler slide with a rubber surface and covering the base of the concrete post attached to the fence near the slide.

Additionally it was discussed that seating areas could be used to cover a portion of the roots observed throughout the play area.

The Comprehensive Records Check Determination must have a Records Check Clearance Date that is no older than the preceding 12 months of the hire date; provided, however, if the Employee has had a lapse of employment from the child care industry that lasted for 180 days (6 months) or longer, a new satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination is required. It was determined based on the observation of staff records that a staff person recently rehired to the in 2019 did not have a comprehensive records check determination, in that authorization was not submitted for the staff to obtain a comprehensive check. it could not be determined how long the staff person was gone from the center requiring staff to submit new fingerprints.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

IMMEDIATE CORRECTION - The Center will review files to ensure that every Employee has a valid and current satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on file prior to being present at the Center while any child is present for care or before an individual age 17 or older resides in the Center. The Comprehensive Records Check Determination must have a Records Check Clearance Date that is no older than the preceding 12 months of the hire date; provided, however, if the Employee has had a lapse of employment from the child care industry that lasted for 180 days (6 months) or longer, a new satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination is required. The program's owner or an officer/member of the corporation must view the A to Z Background Check video units pertaining to this records check rule and return the signed affidavit within one week from this visit date. The center will ensure the CRC rules are maintained.

It was determined based on observation that ratio of 1:10 was maintained in the 1-2 year old mixed group located in room A. Three of the children were one years of age per staff, requiring a ratio of 2:10 to be maintained in the mixed group.
