It was determined based on observation that the ventilation fan in Main A-Back right one year olds and two year olds bathroom was not kept clean and dust was observed.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will have the Center and surrounding areas cleaned, make repairs where needed, and remove all debris is removed. The Center will implement a plan to keep areas clean and in good repair that includes regular monitoring.

It was determined based on observation that the preschool play structure with the two blue slides had less than three inches of resilient surfacing underneath the fall zones.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will add additional resilient surfacing to the fall zones where needed and check daily, adding resilient surfacing as needed to maintain adequate resiliency.
