- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.

It was determined based on observation that the following repairs and cleanings were needed:

- -F/R Middle: The vents in the boys and girls bathroom were observed to be dusty. The left sink was observed to be filling up.
- -G/3R: The vents in the boys and girls bathroom were observed to be dusty. The right sink was observed to be filling up.
- -I/1R: The vents in the boys and girls bathroom were observed to be dusty.
- -In the hallway outside the infant classroom: Water stained was observed on the ceiling.
- -In the lunch room: The ceiling was observed to be peeling.

The provider has put plan in place regarding redirecting children, documenting and having conversations with parents. The provider will also seek help from the Inclusion Department, and staff has taken training.

Discussed revision to the supervision rule which states: Staff shall be attentive and participating with all children during mealtimes and shall be seated within an arm's length away from children thirty-six (36) months of age and younger.
