The consultant discussed the Executive Order, the new infant feeding forms and the new rule regarding supervision of staff during meal and snack times.

The center has purchased a large gym set from Play Boss with the STABLE money. The center director this peice of equipment gives a new look to their center and expressed her appreciation.

 All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
 Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
 Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee
