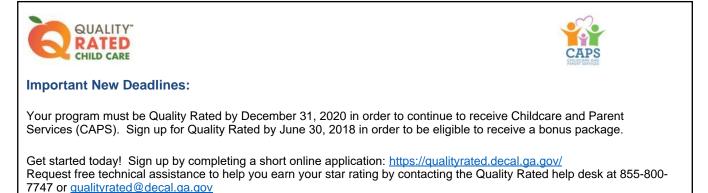

It was determined based on observation that the toddler hallway bathroom was observed to be without an exhaust fan or window on this date.

Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route.
