The plan must apply to all children in care and include specific accommodations for infants and toddlers, children with disabilities, and children with chronic medical conditions and shall include assurance that no Center Personnel will impede in any way the delivery of emergency care or services to a child by licensed or certified emergency health care professionals. It was determined based on consultant observation and conversation with provider, that provider did not have access to a completed emergency plan. Provider stated that the emergency plan was under a sink that leaked and will have to print another one.
