Finding

591-1-1-.26(6) requires that playground equipment provide an opportunity for the children to engage in a variety of experiences and shall be age-appropriate. For example, toddlers shall not be permitted to swing in swings designed for School-age Children. The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based on observation that the rubber tire was not attached to the metal cap on one of the tricycle on the merry-go-round.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will make the tricycle inaccessible tot the children until it can be repaired. Staff will check the equipment daily to ensure that the equipment is free of hazards, rust and splinters.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that that the following hazards were on the playground on this date:

- -two active ant beds near the tricyle merry go round
- -the wooden board barrier in front of the swing was no longer attached.
- -exposed tree roots and electrical cords were on the ground on the side of the building leading to the playground.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.
