Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on observation that the playground fence was not four feet high in some sections. It was approximately three and a half feet at the lowest point.

The Center will routinely check the fence to determine if it is in good repair and remains at least 4 feet high, and will repair any hazards. The Center will train Staff to identify and report any fence hazards and to keep the fence gates closed when not in use.
