- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

591-1-1-.05 Animals Not Met

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.05(1) requires Center Staff to control animals to assure proper sanitation of the premises is maintained and animals are not a hazard to the children, Personnel or visitors. No animals, such as but not limited to, pit bull dogs, ferrets, and poisonous snakes, which may have a vicious propensity, shall be permitted on the Center premises at any time there are children on the premises. Horses or other farm animals shall not be quartered on any property over which Center Staff exercises any control that is located within five hundred (500) feet of the building in which the Center is located. It was determined based on measurements that the farm animals and cages begin at 184 feet from the back of the child playground and not 500 feet as required. The center director will apply for a waiver / variance by 09-30-2019.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center director stated she is going to apply for a waiver / variance by 09-30-2019.

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.05(3) requires Center Staff to ensure animals are properly vaccinated and to maintain documentation of the vaccinations at the Center. It was determined based on the center director's statement that vaccinations are administered to all aminals however no proof of vaccinations are available for review. The center director stated she will begin keeping a vaccination log of all animals.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will obtain all necessary vaccinations for animals on the premises and will file and store the records on site.
