#### **Comments**

This Monitoring Visit is the second regulatory visit for Little Folks Farm & Childcare this 2018 - 2019 fiscal year.

The consultant reviewed all staff files and finds that one staff member does not have a satisfactory comprehensive fingerprint criminal records clearance determination letter on file.

The center is renovating the playground area and adding square footage and fencing. The playground is temporarily closed until the fencing is complete. The consultant took measurements of the new fencing and will complete an amendment to add square footage once the playground fencing is complete and the consultant received a request for an amendment. from the center.

The center director stated no medication is administered, no field trips or routine transportation is provided.

591-1-1-.33(3) requires each staff member with direct care responsibilities to complete health and safety training at the time of employment that will count toward required annual training: Staff employed prior to September 30, 2016 will complete the training by December 29, 2016 and Staff employed after September 30, 2016 will complete the health and safety training within the first 90 days of employment. It was determined based on the consultant's observation of all staff files and PDR that a employee hired April 9, 2018 has not completed Health & Safety and Orientation as required.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will develop and implement a plan to schedule and track this training for all employees based on their hire dates.

#### Finding

591-1-1-.33(4) requires all Staff who provide any direct care to children, except independent contractors, Students-in-Training and volunteers, to obtain ten (10) clock hours of training or instruction in child care issues from an accredited school or Department-approved source. At least six (6) of the clock hours must be divided as follows: four (4) clock hours of training in any of the following topics: disease control, cleanliness, basic hygiene, illness detection, illness disposition and childhood injury control and two (2) clock hours of training in identifying, reporting and meeting the needs of abused, neglected or deprived children. It was determined based on the consultant's review of all staff files and review of PDR that a employee hired April 9, 2018 has not completed 10 hours of initial training as required.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will plan and schedule training and follow up to ensure that direct care Staff complete the required hours of training in the required subjects.

### 591-1-1-.32 Staff: Child Ratios and Group Size(CR)

#### Finding

591-1-1-.32(1) requires the Center to maintain the required Staff:child ratios as follows: under 1 year or under 18 months if not walking = 1:6; 1 year and walking = 1:8; 2 years = 1:10; 3 years = 1:15; 4 years = 1:18; 5 years = 1:20; and 6 years and older = 1:25. A Center must establish groupings of children for care with maximum group sizes as follows: under 1 year = 12; under 18 months/not walking = 12; 1 year and walking = 16; 2 years = 20; 3 years = 30; 4 years = 36; 5 years = 40; and 6 years and older = 50. It was determined based on the consultant's observation and child head count that one staff member was present with one child the age of eight months, three children the age of one and six children the age of two.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will hire additional Staff or reschedule current Staff to meet required Staff:child ratios and will organize children into groups that meet requirements.
