A virtual inspection was conducted on September 1, 2020 with Tracey Broxton. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Compliance with the Executive Order issued on August 15, 2020 was reviewed during the virtual inspection.

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Finding

591-1-1-.30(1)(a)2 requires that a crib mattress is firm, tight-fitting without gaps, at least 2 inches thick and covered with a waterproof, washable material. Before a change of occupant, each mattress shall be cleaned with a disinfectant. It was determined based on observation that three out of seven cribs had mattresses that were not covered with a waterproof material.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The consultant spoke with the director about purchasing waterproof mattress pads to cover with mattresses and ensure that they are waterproof as required. The provider temporarily shut down the center due to the COVID-19 pandemic and has had trouble with purchasing the new mattresses. She stated that she will try to ensure the mattresses are purchased in September now that the center is back open.
