An Administrative Review was conducted on 8/16/21. Staff files, children's files, training, and background checks were all reviewed. A virtual inspection was conducted on 8/18/21 with the Director. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Compliance with the Executive Order issued on June 15, 2021, was reviewed during the virtual inspection.
