- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on an investigation that on September 20, 2018, at 10:45 a.m. a three-year-old child tripped and fell over a tree root on the playground. The child sustained minor injuries to the forehead and lip and lost a tooth as a result of the fall. The child received professional medical attention as a precaution.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards. The center has submitted a work order for the tree roots to be removed. If the work order is not approved, the tree roots should be cut down so they are flush with the ground and are not tripping hazards or center staff will ensure that children do not have access to the roots during outside time on the playground.
