The consultant left a one-day letter for one staff member hired in January 2019 with a satisfactory records check determination and not a comprehensive record check determination. The director was able to obtain the satisfactory comprehensive records check determination before the consultant left.



The Comprehensive Records Check Determination must have a Records Check Clearance Date that is no older than the preceding 12 months of the hire date; provided, however, if the Employee has had a lapse of employment from the child care industry that lasted for 180 days (6 months) or longer, a new satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination is required. It was determined based on director's statement that an employee that was hired on January 02, 2019 was present without a satisfactory comprehensive record check determination.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure that every Employee has a valid and current satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on file prior to being present at the Center while any child is present for care or before an individual age 17 or older resides in the Center. The Comprehensive Records Check Determination must have a Records Check Clearance Date that is no older than the preceding 12 months of the hire date; provided, however, if the Employee has had a lapse of employment from the child care industry that lasted for 180 days (6 months) or longer, a new satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination is required. The director was able to call the corporate office and get a fingerprint determination while the consultant was present.
