Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that a potential entrapment hazard existed when a four inch gap was observed on the bottom back fence panel on the back preschool large playground.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will routinely check the fence to determine if it is in good repair and will repair any hazards. The Center will train Staff to identify and report any fence hazards. The owner stated that the panel with be repaired as soon as possible.
