Finding

591-1-1-.26(6) requires that playground equipment provide an opportunity for the children to engage in a variety of experiences and shall be age-appropriate. For example, toddlers shall not be permitted to swing in swings designed for School-age Children. The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined, based on an observation that a robe was detached and hanging from the robe climbing structure located on the B - School Age playground on this date.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will provide a variety of age-appropriate equipment that is arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. Staff will check the equipment daily to ensure that the equipment is free of hazards, rust and splinters.

It was determined, based on an observation that menu substitutions were not recorded and posted on the center's menu for menu changes made on Thursday, November 30, 2017.

The Center will list all of the current week's meals and snacks and all substitutions on the menu and keep past menus on file for six months and will implement a system to monitor this.

It was determined, based on an observation that there were several packages of food opened and not stored in containers with tight-fitting lids/covers in the kitchen pantry area. It was further determined, that can foods and juice were located on the floor of the kitchen pantry area on this date.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will designate an appropriate area for the storage of containers of food, will make available containers, lids, and covers, and will train Staff on proper storage and labeling.

591-1-1-.14 First Aid & CPR Not Met

Finding

591-1-1-.14(2) requires a Staff member who is trained in CPR and first aid to be on the premises and on any field trip whenever any child is present. In addition, Staff who provide direct care to children must satisfactorily obtain certification in first aid and CPR by December 29, 2016 if employed prior to September 30, 2016 and within 90 days of their hire date if employed after September 30, 2016. It was determined, based on a review of records that two employees hired February 2, 2017 and August 14, 2017 did not have documentation of current first aid and CPR training on file. It was further determined, that an employee hired June 12, 2017 did not have documentation of current CPR training on file.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will develop a schedule to ensure there is always a staff person with current first aid and CPR training present and will develop and implement a plan to ensure all staff members have satisfactorily completed first aid and CPR training by the specified date.

Finding

591-1-1-.33(3) requires each staff member with direct care responsibilities to complete health and safety training at the time of employment that will count toward required annual training: Staff employed prior to September 30, 2016 will complete the training by December 29, 2016 and Staff employed after September 30, 2016 will complete the health and safety training within the first 90 days of employment. It was determined, based on a review of records that four (4) employees hired July 1, 2016; February 2, 2017; August 2, 2017; and August 14, 2017 did not have documentation of health and safety orientation training on file.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will develop and implement a plan to schedule and track this training for all employees based on their hire dates.

Finding

591-1-1-.33(4) requires all Staff who provide any direct care to children, except independent contractors, Students-in-Training and volunteers, to obtain ten (10) clock hours of training or instruction in child care issues from an accredited school or Department-approved source. At least six (6) of the clock hours must be divided as follows: four (4) clock hours of training in any of the following topics: disease control, cleanliness, basic hygiene, illness detection, illness disposition and childhood injury control and two (2) clock hours of training in identifying, reporting and meeting the needs of abused, neglected or deprived children. It was determined, based on a review of records that an employee hired July 1, 2016 did not have six (6) hours of required first year training on file.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will plan and schedule training and follow up to ensure that direct care Staff complete the required hours of training in the required subjects.

Finding

591-1-1-.33(5) requires the Director and person with primary responsibility for food preparation to have four clock hours of training in food nutrition planning, preparation, serving, proper dish washing and food storage. It was determined, based on a review of records that the director did not have documentation of two (2) hours of nutrition training on file.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will schedule food preparation training, as required, and follow up to ensure the training is completed.

It was determined, based on a review of records that the dance and karate independent instructor at the facility during the time of consultant's visit did not have a a satisfactory criminal records check on file.

The Center will obtain a satisfactory Fingerprint Records Check Determination for the Independent Contractor. The Center will ensure that every independent contractor that offers consistent educational or physical activities to children in care has a satisfactory Fingerprint Records Check Determination. Independent contractors MUST have a satisfactory records check determination to be at the facility when a child is present for care.
