- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Annual vehicle inspection was observed for all vehicles used in transporting children this date.

Finding

591-1-1-.36(7)(c)2. requires that the driver or other designated person shall immediately document in writing, with a check or other mark/symbol to account for each child listed on the passenger transportation checklist each time a child enters and exits the vehicle. The driver or other designated staff person shall document in writing with a different mark/symbol to account for each child listed on the passenger transportation checklist who was not present on the vehicle for any reason. An explanation shall be documented in writing whenever a child is transported to a field trip site but is not present on the return trip to the Center. It was determined based on review of records that on June 5, 2019, one child was not checked off the van for afternoon transportation from the Strawberry Farm back to the center. On June 10, 2019 one child was not checked on or off the van for morning transportation from Seven Arts Center back to the center. On June 20, 2019, one child was not checked on or off morning and afternoon transportation from the center to Dazzles and from Dazzles back to the center. On July 16, 2019, two children were not check on and off the vehicle for afternoon transportation from the center to Urban Jungle for a field trip.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The driver/other designated person will immediately document in writing with a check/mark/symbol each time a child gets on and off the vehicle.

Finding

591-1-1-.36(7)(d)2. requires that the second designated Staff person conduct a check of the vehicle immediately upon the completion of the first check of the vehicle. The responsible person shall physically walk through the entire vehicle; visually inspect all seat surfaces, under all seats and in all compartments or recesses in the vehicle's interior; and sign the passenger transportation checklist(s), indicating all of the children have exited the vehicle. There shall be continuous watchful oversight of the vehicle between the first check and second check. It was determined based on review of records that on June 5, 2019, there was not a first or second check completed for afternoon transportation from Strawberry Farm back to the center. On June 10, 2019, there was not a first or second check completed for morning transportation. On June 12, 2019, there was not a second check completed for afternoon transportation from Six Flags back to the center. On June 13, 2019, there was not a first or second check completed for afternoon transportation from the Center for Puppetry Arts back to the center. On June 14, 2019, there was not a first or second check completed for afternoon transportation from the Fern Bank back to the center. On June 20, 2019, there was not a first or second check completed for afternoon transportation from Dazzles back to the center. On June 27, 2019, there was not a second check completed for morning or afternoon transportation from Dazzles Skating back to the center. On July 17, 2019, there was not a second check completed for afternoon transportation from Six Flags back to the center. On July 18, 2019 there was not a first or second check completed for afternoon transportation from Fun Spot back to the center. On July 24, 2019, there was not a first or second check completed for afternoon transportation from Stevie B's back to the center.

The Center will train Staff who are or may be involved in transporting children in how to thoroughly inspect a vehicle and properly complete transportation documentation. The Center will review and monitor.

Finding

591-1-1-.32(5) requires that during day-time rest or sleeping periods, at least one Staff person is in each room providing direct supervision of the children and all Staff required by these rules relating to Staff: child ratios are in the Center and available to assure safe evacuation in an emergency. Staff: child ratios may be doubled for children three (3) years and older provided these requirements are met. It was determined based on observation that during nap time in the far back classroom of the back building it was one teacher to 11 one-year-olds ratio when a one to eight ratio was required. Further, in the first left classroom was observed to have one staff member to 12 infants and one-year-olds for approximately five minutes during nap/ break time.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will rearrange staff schedules to ensure the required number of staff are in each room and available.
