- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- · Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

#### **Finding Associated with Complaint**

591-1-1-.26(8) requires climbing and swinging equipment to have a resilient surface beneath the equipment and the fall zone from such equipment must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resiliency.

It was determined that on August 5, 2019, there was no resilient surface beneath or in the fall zone of the monkey bars when a five-year-old child fell. The child was sitting on a bar of the equipment that was approximately 28 inches off the ground. He leaned slightly backwards and fell on his arm. Center staff rendered first aid. The child's parents and 911 emergency services were called. The child was transported to the hospital via ambulance and was diagnosed with a serious arm injury.
