The consultant read the consultant script, left a one-day letter, and A to Z Unit Criminal Record Check Video Affidavit with the director on this date for two staff members with a national satisfactory criminal records check.

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. It was determined based on review of records that the director was in a classroom unsupervised with a national satisfactory criminal records check. The consultant read the consultant script, left a one-day letter, and left the A to Z video affidavit with the director on this date.

The Comprehensive Records Check Determination must have a Records Check Clearance Date that is no older than the preceding 12 months of the hire date; provided, however, if the Employee has had a lapse of employment from the child care industry that lasted for 180 days (6 months) or longer, a new satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination is required. It was determined based on review of records that one staff member was left unsupervised in a classroom with a nation satisfactory criminal records check on this date. The consultant read the consultant script, left a one-day letter, and left the affidavit with the director on this date.
