Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.11(1) requires that disciplinary actions used to correct a child's behavior, guidance techniques and any activities in which the children participate or observe at the Center shall not be detrimental to the physical or mental health of any child. It was based on an investigation, that on undetermined dates, center staff provided inappropriate disciplinary actions to correct children's behavior. Staff instructed children to complete writing assignments such as,"I will not be disrespectful to my teachers and "I will not talk when someone else is talking". The children were instructed to write the sentences two or three hundred times.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

Center staff will cease use of this disciplinary method; the director will provide staff training on appropriate child quidance techniques and have a system in place to monitor and identify/prevent inappropriate actions.
