It was determined that based on the consultants observation of bus number two and three were observed to have missing handles on the drivers door. It was also determined that bus number one was observed to have four seats that had exposed foam, and not 100% secured to the base of the seat. Bus two had one seat completely off of the base, and exposed foam, though the bus is only used for emergencies when needed.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will maintain that all transportation vehicles are clean, in safe repair, and free from hazards. The seats will be properly secured to the base as required to ensure that all children are safe. Tape will be added to ensure that foam and worn areas are not exposed.
