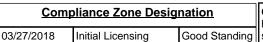

It was determined based on consultant's observation that a hazard existed in that a shelf was observed to be wobbly and could easily be tipped over in classroom A.

### **Finding**

591-1-1-.08(1) requires the Center Staff to maintain a file for each child while such child is in care and for one year after that child is no longer enrolled. In order for the file to be complete, the file shall contain the following: child's name, birth date, sex, address, living arrangement, name of school if applicable; names of both Parents, home and work addresses, and home and work telephone numbers; name(s) and addresses of the person(s) to whom the child may be released including address, telephone numbers, relationship to child and to Parent(s), and other identifying information; name(s) and telephone number(s) of person(s) to contact in emergencies when the Parent cannot be reached; name and telephone number of the child's primary source of health care; and a statement regarding known allergies, physical problems, mental health disorders, mental retardation or developmental disabilities which limit the child's participation in the program. It was determined based on consultant's review of the files that four (4) of five (5) children's files were missing the address of the person to whom the child may be released.

# **POI** (Plan of Improvement)

Center staff will create a new roster that will have the address to whom the child is released to be in compliance with the state rules and regulations.

591-1-1-,06 Bathrooms Not Met

#### Finding

591-1-1-.06(4) requires a Center first licensed after March 1, 1991, and Centers that remodel or add to existing plumbing facilities, to have the bathroom area fully enclosed and ventilated to the outside of the building with either an open screened window or functioning exhaust fan and duct system and requires Centers without fully enclosed bathrooms to ensure there is adequate ventilation to control odors and adequate sanitation measures to prevent the spread of contagious diseases. It was determined based on consultant's observation that the ventilation fans in all bathrooms were not functioning properly.

#### **POI** (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will have have the maintenance person to repair the ventilation fans so that they are functioning properly.

Correction Deadline: 4/26/2018

#### **Finding**

591-1-1-.06(6) requires Center Staff to equip bathrooms with soap, toilet tissue and single-use towels or cloth towels used only once between launderings. It was determined based on consultant's observation that there was no soap in the dispensers in the girls and boys bathrooms by classroom A.

The Center will provide soap for the children to wash their hands.

The license capacity for the facility is nineteen (19) children. The facility also has a twenty-five (25) square foot capacity of twenty-seven (27) children.

# 591-1-1-.25 Physical Plant - Safe Environment(CR)

#### **Finding**

591-1-1-.25(13) requires that potentially hazardous equipment, materials and supplies be stored in a locked area inaccessible to children. It was determined based on consultant's observation that a hazard existed in that cleaning supplies and scotch guard were accessible to children in the unlocked cabinets under the sink in classroom A and in the cabinet in the resource room. Consultant also observed cords hanging from the television and the phone in classroom A.

# POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure that all cleaning supplies are in a locked cabinet and inaccessible to children and ensure the TV cords are secured to the wall so children do not have access to them.
