The center director stated liability insurance is provided, no medication is administered, no field trips or routine transportation is provided.

The consultant reviewed all staff files and finds that each staff member has a comprehensive fingerprint criminal records clearance determination letter on file except for one employee. This employee has a satisfactory national fingerprint criminal records clearance determination letter on file. The center director stated this employee is part time and supervised at all times by a employee who has a satisfactory comprehensive fingerprint criminal records clearance determination letter on file.

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. 591-1-1-.33(3) requires each staff member with direct care responsibilities to complete health and safety training at the time of employment that will count toward required annual training: Staff employed prior to September 30, 2016 will complete the training by December 29, 2016 and Staff employed after September 30, 2016 will complete the health and safety training within the first 90 days of employment. It was determined based on the consultant's review of all staff files that one employee hired August 16, 2018 had not completed health and safety training. Additionally, a second employee hired July 16, 2018 had not completed health and safety training.
