Baby bottles shall never be propped; the infant's head shall be elevated while feeding. It was determined based on consultant's observation that an infant was not elevated while feeding. The infant was lying in a bouncer/rocker while drinking his bottle.

## POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff to hold an infant or place them in a high chair to elevate infant's heads during feeding.
