- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. ### Finding

591-1-1-.25(3) requires the Center and surrounding premises to be kept clean, free of debris and in good repair. Hygienic measures such as, but not limited to, screened windows and proper waste disposal procedures shall be utilized to minimize the presence of rodents, flies, roaches and other vermin at the Center. It was determined based on an observation that the half wall in the reading center of Classroom E was unsecure and easily shaken.

### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will make repairs where needed. The Center will implement a plan to keep areas clean and in good repair that includes regular monitoring. The Center will remove or repair the half wall so that it is secure.

# **Finding**

591-1-1-.26(7) requires that climbing and swinging equipment be anchored. It was determined based on an observation that the purple play equipment on Playground - Left Side was not securely anchored to the ground. It was further determined, that the bolts were protruding out of the base and posed as a potential tripping hazard.

### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove or repair equipment that is not anchored and will regularly inspect the equipment to ensure it remains anchored.

### Finding

591-1-1-.15(1) requires that meals and snacks are served, with serving sizes dependent upon the age of the child, that meet nutritional guidelines as established by the United States Department of Agriculture Child and Adult Care Food Program. Meals and snacks shall be varied daily, and additional servings of nutritious food shall be offered to children over and above the required daily minimum, if not contraindicated by special diets. It was determined based on an observation that all children in Classroom A were served Lactaid milk for lunch and all children in Classroom C were served chocolate milk for lunch.

# POI (Plan of Improvement)

Center Staff will prepare menus and/or serve foods that meet the USDA guidelines. Center Staff will serve Lactaid milk only to the children with the needed supplement.

### **Finding**

591-1-1-.15(4) requires that a feeding chair or similar equipment designed for feeding children shall be provided for the use of each child being fed who is capable of sitting up but who is unable to sit unassisted at a table and must be cleaned with a disinfectant after each use. Such chair or similar equipment shall have a broad base to prevent tipping, a surface that the child cannot raise, a strap or other device which prevents the child from sliding out of the chair, and a feeding surface free of cracks. It was determined based on an observation that three of three children in Classroom B were not buckled into the kidney table, as required, while being fed lunch.

### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will inspect feeding equipment to ensure it meets each of the listed criteria and to verify a feeding chair or equipment is provided for each child who requires one. The Center will train staff and monitor to ensure that the feeding equipment is cleaned with a disinfectant after each use.

591-1-1-.20(1) requires Personnel to obtain specific written authorization from the child's physician or parent in order to dispense prescription or non-prescription medications, except for first aid. Such authorization will include when applicable, date; full name of the child; name of the medication; prescription number, if any; dosage; the dates to be given; the time of day to be dispensed; and signature of parent. It was determined based on a director statement that the center did not obtain written authorization to dispense medication to a child on October 7, 2019 and October 8, 2019.

# POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff to obtain and review parental authorizations to ensure the authorization contains complete information. The designated person(s) will monitor daily.

### **Finding**

591-1-1-.20(3) requires the Center to maintain a record of medication dispensed that includes the date, time and amount of medication, any noticeable adverse reaction, and the signature or initials of the person administering the medication. It was determined based on a staff statement that medication was not documented when a breathing treatment was given to a child on October 7, 2019 and October 8, 2019.

### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff responsible for dispensing medication in the accurate completion and storage of the records and will implement a plan to monitor this.

It was determined based on an observation that children in Classroom A and Classroom C were not offered a light cover during rest time.

The Center will ensure that a light cover is available for each child and will meet the requirements for laundering.

591-1-Ī-.14(1)(a) requires, in a Center that provides transportation, that either the driver or another Staff person present on the vehicle have current evidence of successful completion of a biennial training program in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and a triennial training program in first aid offered by certified or licensed health care professionals or trainers and which dealt with the provision of emergency care to infants and children. It was determined based on an observation that Staff #1 did not obtain the required First Aid and CPR training before engaging in transportation responsibilities.

### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will verify proof of CPR/1st aid training and schedule Staff so that there is always a staff person on the vehicle with this training.

It was determined based on a review of records that one staff hired on June 5, 2018 did not obtain the required health and safety orientation training.

The Center will develop and implement a plan to schedule and track this training for all employees based on their hire dates. The director will ensure all new staff obtain health and safety training within 90 days of hire.
