If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Finding

591-1-1-.09(1)(c) requires the Center to ensure that every Employee has a valid and current satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on file prior to being present at the Center while any child is present for care or before an individual age 17 or older resides in the Center. The Comprehensive Records Check Determination must have a Records Check Clearance Date that is no older than the preceding 12 months of the hire date; provided, however, if the Employee has had a lapse of employment from the child care industry that lasted for 180 days (6 months) or longer, a new satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination is required. It was determined based on observation that staff member #10 and staff member #27 did not have a current satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on file prior to being present at the Center. Staff member #10 was observed to be in Classroom B-One Year, caring for one-yearolds during naptime, there were two other staff members in the room at the time. Staff member #23 was observed to be assisting in various classrooms throughout the center.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

IMMEDIATE CORRECTION - The Center will put in place a procedure to ensure that every Employee has a valid and current satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on file prior to being present at the Center while any child is present for care or before an individual age 17 or older resides in the Center. The Comprehensive Records Check Determination must have a Records Check Clearance Date that is no older than the preceding 12 months of the hire date; provided, however, if the Employee has had a lapse of employment from the child care industry that lasted for 180 days (6 months) or longer, a new satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination is required. The program's owner or an officer/member of the corporation must view the A to Z Background Check video units pertaining to this records check rule and return the signed affidavit within one week from this visit date. The center will put in place a procedure to ensure the CRC rules are maintained.

It was determined based on review of records, staff members #13, #15, #22, #29 were not certified in CPR and First Aid.

It was determined based on review of documents staff members #13, #15, #20 and #22 did not complete the initial center orientation checklist.
